



Due to requirements of our public liability insurance, the safety of all involved in the festival and VIC Road requirements all rules below need to be adhered to and understood by all persons on the participating parade float.

Rules for Parade

1. All vehicles entered into the parade must be in a roadworthy condition with respect to the: brake system, driver access & ventilation, exhaust system, steering, stop lamps, turn signal lamps, visibility for the driver, including effective rear vision on both sides, warning devices.
2. The Tarra Festival Parade Marshall reserves the right to deem a vehicle unsafe.
3. All drivers of vehicles must be licensed.
4. Vehicles are to be used in a safe manner at all times
5. All persons participating in the parade are to obey instructions from the parade marshals.
6. Maximum speed 5kph.
7. Safe distance of 30 metres between floats.
8. Children on floats to be seated at all times, remain wholly within the float or vehicle. No arms and legs hanging over the side.
9. Children participating in the parade are to be supervised by an adequate number of adults.
10. No objects to be thrown from the floats or vehicles. (eg. No Easter Eggs or Lollies)
11. The float organiser must ensure the safety of any structures, bunting, decorations and passengers.
12. Rules are to be read and signed by drivers and the person entering the float or vehicle before the start of the parade.
