#### Delivery of Works

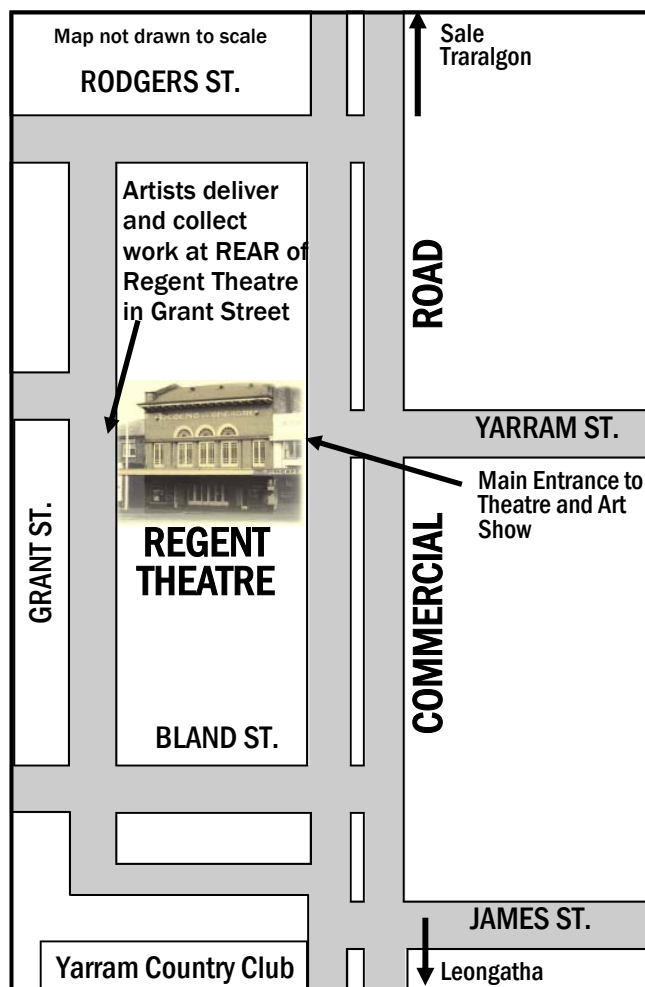

- The artist is entitled to one complimentary ticket for the opening ceremony. Additional tickets may be purchased at the door.

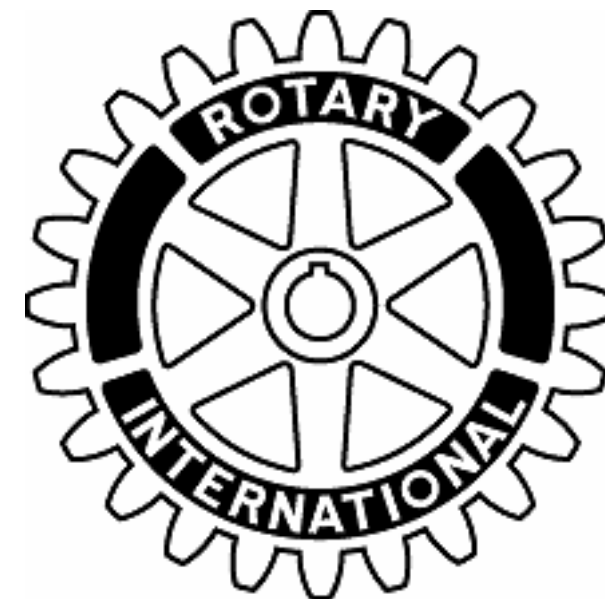

# Conditions of Entry

## General

- The Committee is a special committee of the Rotary Club of Yarram.
- All completed Entry Forms and Entry Fees must be received **no later than 31 March 2009**
- The hanging space for works is strictly limited and entries will be accepted in the order in which they are received.
- All entries **must** be suitably framed and fitted with wire ready for hanging. No screw eyes, or projecting hooks of any kind permitted. Student entries that are unframed but suitably mounted will be accepted.
- All entries must have the name of the artist, title of the painting, the medium, and the selling price on the back of the painting.
- Each artist may submit a maximum of five works . They must be the original work of the artist and *must not have been previously shown at Yarram.*
- The maximum size for any entry is one square metre, including frame.** Oversize works will not be accepted
- The Committee reserves the right to refuse to display any work for any reason whatsoever.
- All entries must be for genuine sale. (Except student entries).
- The Rotary Club of Yarram and the Committee will exercise all reasonable care with the works entered but will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any work while in its custody or for insurance cover on works either during transport or on display.
- The Committee may allow any work entered to be reproduced by newspaper and/or television for the purpose of advertising the Art Show.
- Decision of the show judges appointed by the Committee is final and no correspondence will be entered into under any circumstances.
- With exception of the Public Choice Prize, any work may win only one prize. The total prize money is \$2800 in eight categories which are as follows;
